Our eviction Prevention program is growing! EPH is looking for a second Prevention Case Manager to join our current staff due to the continued increase in the need for Prevention services in our community. Our Prevention program began in 2018 to address the root causes of homelessness. The primary role of the Prevention Case Manager position will be to work with local landlords and a comprehensive group of community service partners, as well as directly with families with children, to pre-empt evictions, providing extensive case management and supportive services as needed. Bachelor's degree or equivalent, and experience in the social work, human services, education or similar field preferred. This is a part-time, approximately 20 hours per week position.
