

THE FATHER WILLIAM GALATY SCHOLARSHIP FOR POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

SPRING 2019

Father William Galaty Scholarships — honoring the memory of the long-time former rector who passed away in 1997 — are awarded annually to members of St. Anne's Episcopal Church, or to dependents of members. Multiple awards are often made in a given year.

Criteria and Application Process

1. Scholarships must be used for purposes of pursuing post-secondary education through an accredited program including associate, bachelor's, master's, or professional degree offerings; technical education; certificate training; or theological or divinity school.
2. Financial need shall be considered, but is not a requisite for eligibility.
(The Scholarship amount is \$500 and is non-renewable).
3. Applications are available at St. Anne's Episcopal Church Office.
4. The five-member selection committee consists of two members of the elected Vestry including the Senior Warden, and three appointed parish members with significant professional experience and/or demonstrated personal commitment to education.
5. Applications for the 2019-20 award cycle must be submitted by Tuesday, April 30, 2019. Recipients will be selected and all applicants informed of the results by Tuesday, June 4, 2019.
6. Checks will be issued directly to the school bursar or billing office specified on the application form. They will be credited to the recipients' accounts at the time of enrollment or fee deadline.
